Has knowledge of own tribe. a) Present themselves before the council and give a short presentation on their tribe OR b) Write a 2 page essay. Present themselves before the council in regalia and give a short exhibition of their style of dance. Can not hold a title with another organization at same time. Photo Release must be signed.

- 2) Princess selected to serve will be notified by phone as well as in writing.
- 3) A sash will be gifted to the incoming princesses by ICMN.
- 4) Incoming princesses are expected to make or have made their own crown.

 (please talk to Princess Committee prior to making of crown)
- 5) The outgoing princess will crown the incoming princess.
 - a) Should there not be an outgoing princess, the incoming princess may:
 - 1) Choose an Elder.
 - 2) A former ICMN Princess.
- 6) The older Princesses wil be a mentor to the younger princesses.
 - a) Sr. Princess mentors Jr. Princess.
 - b) Jr. Princess mentors Tiny Tot Princess.
- 7) Princesses will be asked to sell Raffle tickets at ICMN Pow Wow's.
- 8) The Princess Committee does not guarentee there will be a princess in each age group.
- 9) The following will result in removal of crown.
 - a) Marriage
 - b) Pregnancy
 - c) Drug Abuse
 - d) Not attending organizations function
 - e) Inappropiate behaviou
 - f) Failure to fulfill duties as set by Princess Committee
 - 1) During a function where the princess is representing the ICMN
 - 2) Disrespecting the Pow Wow arena
