

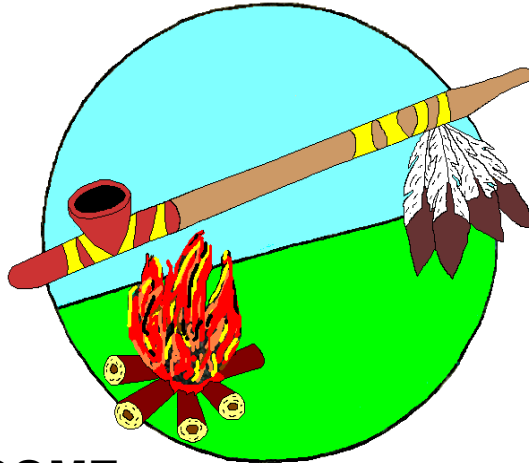

Winter Pow Wow: Basic Terms and Conditions

Contract

This application properly executed by exhibitor, shall upon acceptance by Pow Wow committee, constitute a valid and binding contract.

Assignment of Space

Booth spaces will be pre-assigned. Please check with the Pow Wow chairperson upon your arrival. Assignment of booths are final.

Types of Exhibits

Exhibits shall be limited to authentic American Indian art and crafts. Interpretations of this restrictions shall be the prerogative of the committee.

Booth space rental rules

Booth space rental rate shall be \$50.00 for craft exhibitors. (Vendor fees are not refundable). The booth spaces are 10' x 12'. Please make checks or money orders out to *Indian Council of Many Nations* and mail to : ICMN, 600 West 39 St., Suite 101, K.C. Mo. 64111.

Security and Insurance

All property of the vendor is understood to be under his or her custody and control, in transit to, within, or from the Pow Wow grounds. It is recommended that exhibitors carry floater insurance to cover material damage to vendors property and public liability insurance against injury to the person and property of others.

Loss and Damages

Exhibitor agrees that the *Indian Council of Many Nations* will not be liable for any damages or injury to person or property during the term of this agreement, from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation, and enjoyment of exhibit space by exhibitor or any person thereon with the consent of the exhibitor. The exhibitor will defend, indemnify, and save harmless the *Indian Council of Many Nations* from any liability whatsoever, and account of any such damage, or injury, whether or not caused by negligence or a breach of an obligation by exhibitor or its employees, or representative.

Responsibility

Exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulations and codes of duly authorized Local, State, and Federal governing bodies, concerning fire, safety, and health.

Agreement

Exhibitor further agrees that the conditions, rules, and regulations of the *Indian Council of Many Nations* are made a part of this contract and that said exhibitor agrees to be bound by each and all of these rules and regulations, and that the management shall have the power to interpret, amend, and enforce all rules and regulations, in the best interest of the Kansas City Pow Wow.
